Dear Governor McMaster,

February 2022 – South Carolina was not a swing state in November 2020. Yet, millions of dollars from at least three private entities flowed into the state. Plenty of reporting has been done on how Facebook founder Mark Zuckerberg, through the Center for Tech and Civic Life (CTCL), flooded county election offices in battlegrounds with cash to subsidize election processes preferred by the outside group. But in the Palmetto State, counties and even the state government had hands out for more than ZuckBucks – eventually **totaling \$6.5 million in grants available to be spent as late as Summer 2021**.ⁱ South Carolina demonstrates how the desire to directly influence election administration by funding preferred election processes is a long-term programmatic goal for left-wing nonprofits. And unless the practice is banned by legislation, it will continue.

Three Rivers of Cash Flowing into SC

Zuckerberg, through the 501(c)(3) CTCL, was the largest source of private money given to election offices across the Palmetto State. The SC State Election Commission reported 39 counties

receiving a total of \$5.2 million in ZuckBucks. The State Election Commission itself took a **\$1.3 million** grant from the **Center for Election Innovation & Research (CEIR)**. In a smaller effort, even **Arnold Schwarzenegger** was fueling private funding of county election offices through a donation of **\$40,000** from his University of Southern California think tank, the Schwarzenegger Institute.ⁱⁱ See the chart below for a full list of the governmental entities that received private funding.

Standout Expenditures

Most of the items listed on expense reports are in keeping with what one would expect to see in terms of personal protective equipment and other COVID-related adjustments. But counties receiving both large and small grants

The Center for Tech and Civic Life (CTCL) is a Chicago, Illinois-based center-left election reform advocacy group formed in 2012. The organization pushes for left-of-center voting policies and election administration. It has a wide reach into local elections offices across the nation and is funded by many left-of-center funding organizations such as the **Skoll Foundation**, the **Democracy Fund**, the **John S. and James L. Knight Foundation**, and the **Rockefeller Brothers Fund**.

In the months leading up to the November 2020 election, **Mark Zuckerberg and his wife Priscilla Chan** reportedly donated a total of \$350 million to CTCL through the **Silicon Valley Community Foundation (SVCF)**, although the actual figure reported in SVCF's IRS disclosures was roughly \$328 million. The couple also donated \$69.5 million to a related organization, the **Center for Election Innovation and Research (CEIR)**, which **channeled the funds to secretaries of state** as COVID-19 "relief grants." Both donations were **paid out to CTCL and CEIR** from the Chan Zuckerberg Initiative, the couple's donor-advised fund (DAF) account at the Silicon Valley Community Foundation.

Vote Early Day

Vote Early Day is a movement by a coalition of nonprofits and businesses which encourages voters to use early ballots and wants October 24 to become the official "Vote Early Day" holiday.

Though Vote Early Day was initially spearheaded by the media company, MTV,^[1] it has become a project of New Venture Fund, a left-of-center grantmaking fund run by Arabella Advisors, a nonprofit consulting firm for other left-of-center nonprofit funds. Conventionally, higher voter turnout rates are assumed to benefit Democrats, though the data on recent elections are more ambiguous.^{[2] [3]}

Vote Early day spent \$100,000 on a full-page advertisement in the *Wall Street Journal* on May 12, 2020, which encouraged business leaders to promote early voting for their employees and customers. The ad listed support from twenty-six major corporations, including Twitter, Viacom/CBS, and Patagonia.^[4]

California Secretary of State Alex Padilla and Georgia Secretary of State Brad Raffensperger are members of Vote Early Day's committee.^[5]

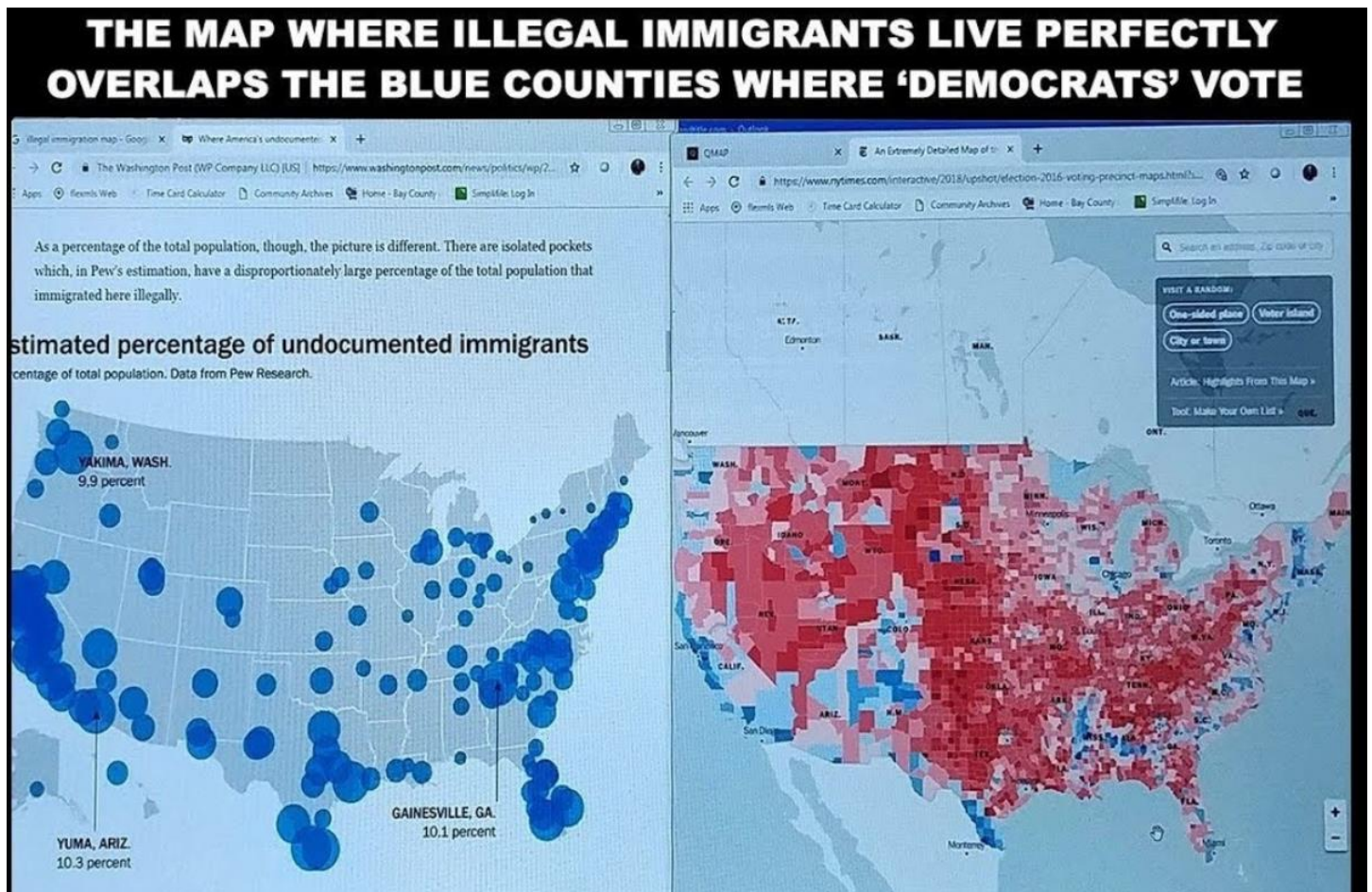
The 3 goals President Trump has CLEARLY laid out for fair and safe elections are:
