





# Do we have "Paper Ballots" in South Carolina?

<p><b>Sign-In to Vote</b></p> <p>ID and Signature Check</p> <p>Get Ballot</p>	<p>E-Poll Book prints blank ballot template</p>  <p>Header text shows election, date, precinct <b>What does the barcode say?</b></p>	<p>Ballot picked up from a pre-printed pile of ballots.</p>  <p>Header text shows election, county, precinct, ballot type, date used or absentee.</p>
<p><b>Voting Booth</b></p>	<p>Insert blank ballot template into Ballot Marking Device (BMD). On the screen, make selections and check them. Hit OK button to print.</p>  <p>Selections are printed in text. <b>What do the barcodes say?</b></p>	<p>Ballot shows all races and candidates for that election and location.</p> <p>Use pencil or pen to fill in Ovals next to desired candidate.</p> 
<p><b>Count Election Results</b></p>	<p>Insert ballot into Tabulator machine slot. Does the Tabulator read the Text you have checked or does it read the barcodes?</p> <p>After precinct polling location is closed, ballots and electronic tally information are taken to County Election Office (and/or sent over the internet).</p> <p><b>Black Box Secret Counting</b> <b>No People Observing</b> <b>Only County Election Office can recount</b></p>	<p>Ballot is the same pre-printed form that you were given but now shows your selections as filled-in ovals beside candidates.</p> <p>Insert ballot into ballot box slot.</p> <p>After precinct polling location is closed, the ballot selections are tallied by redundant teams of people and afterwards taken to the County Election Office.</p> <p><b>Public Counting</b> <b>Multiple People Observing</b> <b>Ability to recount at Precinct</b></p>
